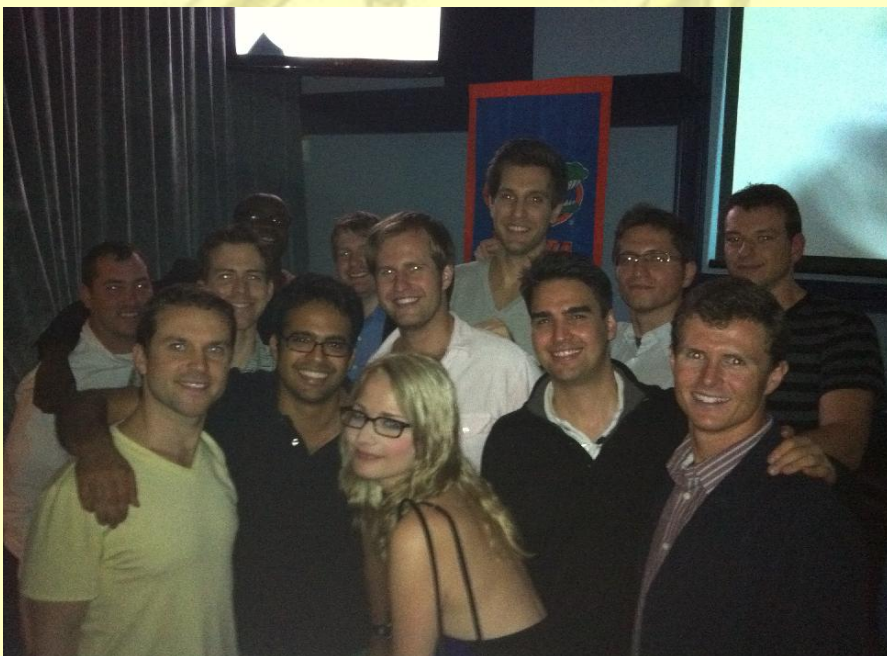

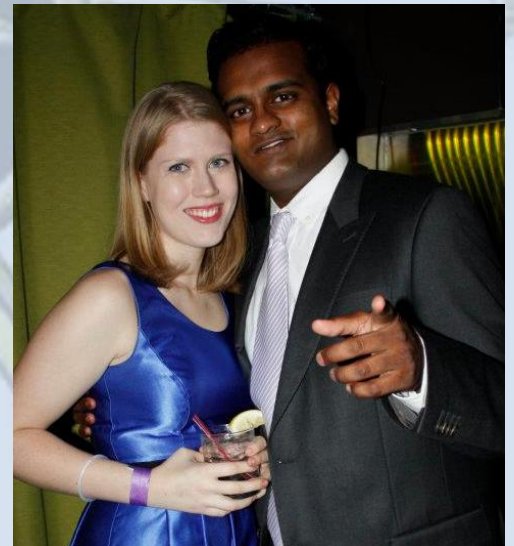


# Winter Formal

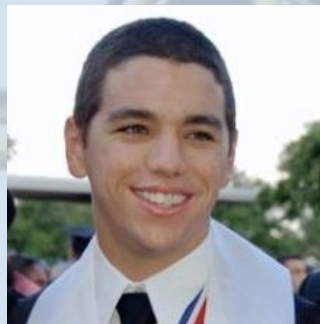

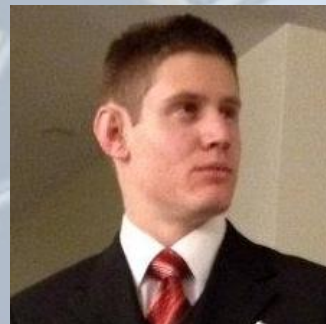
